

Back-to-School Covid-19 Resource Guide

If your child is COVID Positive or Symptomatic:

Positive Test Result

• Students are required to quarantine for 5 days regardless of vaccination status. COVID positive students who are symptom free can return to school after 5 days from the time of the positive test (Day 0 is the day of the Positive Test).

Symptomatic

- Students are required to quarantine for 5 days (Day 0 is the day that symptoms appear).
- *Students returning after day 5 are recommended to wear a mask upon return for days 6-10.
- *CDC states that you can return from quarantine if your symptoms are improving and you are fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication).

If your child has been exposed/a close contact to COVID:

- If your child is symptomatic, please refer to the guidance above.
- If your child is asymptomatic, they may remain in school and monitor for symptoms.
- *If the student was in close contact with a known case of COVID it is recommended that they mask for 10 days from exposure.

KCS Communication:

- KCS will be updating the COVID-19 Dashboard on the district website weekly with information on positive cases reported to schools.
- In the case that KCS/CHA identifies the potential for a classroom, group or school outbreak, KCS will utilize more intensive communication with parents and students (e.g., group, classroom, school communication).
