



Dear Cabarrus County Schools parents/guardians,

Cabarrus Health Alliance (CHA) is happy to offer a convenient option for your child to get the Covid-19 vaccine. Cabarrus County School District will be partnering with CHA to offer Covid-19 vaccination to all students ages 5 and up, as well as family and community members.

Vaccinations will be offered on **Friday January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at Kannapolis Middle School between 4:00pm and 6:30pm**. Vaccination is optional, and parents/guardians must give their permission for children to get vaccinated. Students can also give their own consent if they are 18 years and older.
