CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Todd Adams called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairman Adams led the Pledge of Allegiance.

CONSIDERATION OF THE NC SCHOOL LEADERS SCHOOLS CLOSINGS UPDATE
FROM MARCH 15, 2020 AT 3:00 PM

Chairman Adams reviewed the meetings that had been held by KCS Administration earlier in the day and relayed the highlights of the update for NC School Leaders.

Dr. Buckwell thanked county, city, and emergency partners and Cabarrus Health Alliance for their guidance and collaboration. He also thanked administrative staff for coming in on a Sunday and for all of their efforts to implement plans in the best interest of students and staff. Additionally, he thanked KCS staff in anticipation of all the work that will be done to ensure students are safe and fed.

Dr. Buckwell then shared a Declaration from the KCS Board of Education:

Monday, March 16th is a mandatory workday. All staff should come to school to assist and support in the closing of schools for the next two weeks.

Certified Staff will receive guidance from supervisors as to planning and actions for the development of e-Learning opportunities for students. In these two weeks that schools are closed by an act of the Governor there are critical employees that may be asked to work for many different purposes. Those employees will be eligible for additional compensation.

There will be a community feeding program beginning Monday, March 16, 2020.

Additional information will be online for feeding locations.

Dr. Jessica Grant shared that a non-emergency helpline is being established for students and families to assist with needs during the time that schools remain closed.

Chairman Adams shared the Board's appreciation for all the work being done in response to this rapidly changing situation.

Mr. Clark made a motion to approve the Declaration. Mrs. Cook gave the second and the motion carried.

Chairman Adams adjourned the meeting at 5:55 p.m.
